### **Notes**

1. Ramsey's body was abandoned by his company after the skirmish. It was taken away by Māori and buried nearby.
2. McKindry was shot in an ambush, carried off and buried by Māori. On 23 March the Herald reported a wooden marker "*Hanuere 16 1861. He Pakeha*" on his grave.
